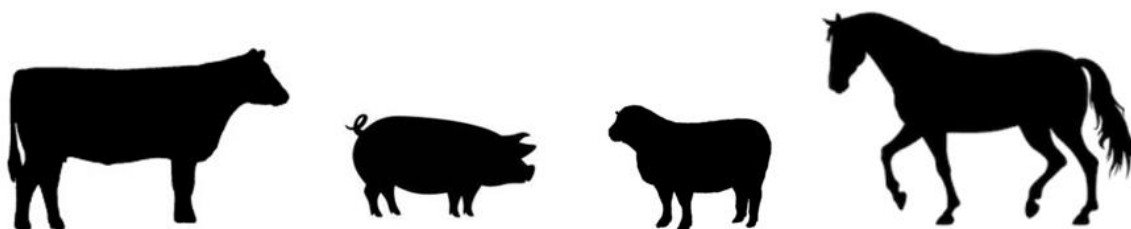

2. All entries to be taken on Show Day.
3. Allocation of points: 1<sup>st</sup> – 3 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 1 point. In the event of a tie, the competitor winning most first prizes will be awarded the Special Prize.
4. YFC Section – Competitions are open to any YFC Members. All competitors must be under 26 years of age on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018.
5. All exhibitors shall provide their own dishes.
6. All exhibits in the Horticultural Section must have been grown by the exhibitor and the committee reserves the right to visit the exhibitor's place of culture and yards, either before or after the Show.
7. Objections, if any, must be made in writing to the Secretary before the presentations with a deposit of £3.00 which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld.
8. The Tent will be out of bounds when judging is in progress.
9. All exhibitors must pay for admission to the Show.
10. Whilst every precaution will be taken to safeguard the exhibits, the Committee will not be held responsible for loss or damage.
11. Presentation of Cups will take place at 4.00pm in the Horticultural tent
12. All goods must be collected between 3.30pm and 4.15pm as Stewards will NOT be on duty after this time.

## **RHEOLAU A RHEOLIADAU'N YMWNEUD Â DA BYW / LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. The Society to be called 'The Tivyside Agricultural Show Society' and its aim to encourage the improvements of Livestock Breeds.
2. **ENTRIES must be submitted on the printed entry form enclosed with the schedule TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FEES to reach the Secretary before midnight on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2019.**
3. The Society reserves the right to cancel any Section if only two exhibitors or less have entered at the time stated in Rule 3.
4. The Society reserves the right to cancel the Show in the event of the weather being such that it would be unreasonable to ask exhibitors to subject their exhibits to the conditions prevailing on the day. Applications for refunds must be received within 5 days, but the Society cannot accept responsibility for any expenses incurred by the exhibitors.
5. All exhibitor are to ensure their animals are correctly identified at the show, equine exhibitors are advised to have their passports with them at the show for inspection.
6. All exhibits to be on the Show ground by 9.00 a.m. on the day of the Show.
7. Judging will commence at 9.00 a.m. prompt.
8. All bulls over 12 months old must be secured by a ring in the nose and cows must be led.
9. All exhibits where height is stipulated must be measured by the Official Veterinary Surgeon before entering the ring or produce a Height Certificate.
10. No exhibit winning a first prize will be allowed to compete in any other classes except Specials, Riding and Harness.
11. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed prize winners only to compete for Championships.
12. Protests and objections (if any) must be made in writing within half an hour of the incident to the Honorary Secretary, and a deposit of £5 paid, and if upheld the money will be refunded.
13. Persons in charge of stock must see that they are properly placed and secured and that they enter the ring when their class is called. They are particularly requested to ensure that their stock is not left unattended at any time.
14. No person is allowed to enter the ring during judging except the judges, stewards and those leading stock.
15. All cattle must be TB tested, and where applicable covered by movement permits. Only cattle from Brucellosis Accredited Herds eligible for entry.
16. The Society will not be responsible for any accident, damage, illness or injury to any exhibit, person or property on the Show field
17. All exhibits to be bona fide property of exhibitor.
18. All In Calf Classes to calve within three months of date of Show.

19. Any competitor who complains of a judge's decision, refuses an award or in any way insults a Show official or judge, shall be liable to have all prize money withheld and entry refused thereafter. Such complaints must be made in writing to the Honorary Secretary before the judging of the Champion Horse.
20. The Committee has the power to eject any entry and expel any person whose entry or presence is detrimental to the interests of the Society.
21. Exhibitors leading animals in the judging ring are not permitted to display any form of livestock advertisement or identification and Stewards and members are not permitted to wear their badges when competing.
22. Assistance with removal of vehicles to the main gate, if requested, will be organised by the Society free of charge.
23. Silver Cups and Trophies must be signed for. Winners held responsible for the Cups and Trophies not won outright and to return them in good condition to the Secretary ONE MONTH before the following year's Show.
24. Perpetual Cups – any exhibitor winning a Perpetual Cup for three successive years will be awarded a Tivyside Agricultural Show Society trophy as a memento.
25. Exhibitors of livestock are particularly requested to assist the Secretary by sending entry fees with entries.
26. The Annual General Meeting will be held within three months of the date of the Show.
27. A Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance/on call during the day. All costs incurred will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
28. All exhibitors must ensure that all handlers/riders are properly attired in the show ring.
29. Vets will be checking cattle out of transporters and stewards will have the authority to inform exhibitors if they feel animals are unruly and not suited for showing.
