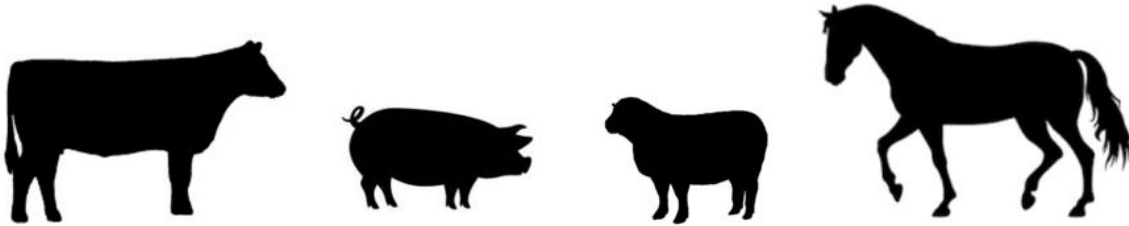

SHETLAND PONIES

The Shetland Pony Society rules for exhibitors must be adhered to.

Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.

IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER MUST HAVE AN "S" NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand entire males 2 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle badge.

1. The Society to be called 'The Tivyside Agricultural Show Society' and its aim to encourage the improvements of Livestock Breeds.
2. **ENTRIES must be submitted on the printed entry form enclosed with the schedule TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FEES to reach the Secretary before midnight on 4th July, 2026.**
3. The Society reserves the right to cancel any Section if only two exhibitors or less have entered at the time stated in Rule 3.
4. The Society reserves the right to cancel the Show in the event of the weather being such that it would be unreasonable to ask exhibitors to subject their exhibits to the conditions prevailing on the day. Applications for refunds must be received within 5 days, but the Society cannot accept responsibility for any expenses incurred by the exhibitors.
5. All exhibitors are to ensure their animals are correctly identified at the show, equine exhibitors are advised to have their passports with them at the show for inspection.
6. All exhibits to be on the Show ground by 9.00 a.m. on the day of the Show.
7. Judging will commence at 9.00 a.m. prompt.
8. All bulls over 12 months old must be secured by a ring in the nose and cows must be led.
9. All exhibits where height is stipulated must be measured by the Official Veterinary Surgeon before entering the ring or produce a Height Certificate.
10. No exhibit winning a first prize will be allowed to compete in any other classes except Specials, Riding and Harness.
11. 1st and 2nd placed prize winners only to compete for Championships.
12. Protests and objections (if any) must be made in writing within half an hour of the incident to the Honorary Secretary, and a deposit of £10 paid, and if upheld the money will be refunded.

15. All cattle must be from TB free herds, and not under any movement restriction.
16. The Society will not be responsible for any accident, damage, illness or injury to any exhibit, person or property on the Show field.
17. All exhibits to be bona fide property of exhibitor.
18. All In Calf Classes to calve within three months of date of Show.
19. Any competitor who complains of a judge's decision, refuses an award or in any way insults a Show official or judge, shall be liable to have all prize money withheld and entry refused thereafter. Such complaints must be made in writing to the Honorary Secretary before the judging of the Champion Horse.
20. The Committee has the power to eject any entry and expel any person whose entry or presence is detrimental to the interests of the Society.
21. Exhibitors leading animals in the judging ring are not permitted to display any form of livestock advertisement or identification and Stewards and members are not permitted to wear their badges when competing.
22. Assistance with removal of vehicles to the main gate, if requested, will be organised by the Society free of charge.
23. Silver Cups, Perpetual Cup and Trophies are not to be taken off the show field; you may have a photograph with your trophy in the secretary's tent.
24. Exhibitors of livestock are particularly requested to assist the Secretary by sending entry fees with entries.
25. The Annual General Meeting will be held within three months of the date of the Show.
26. A Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance/on call during the day. All costs incurred will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
27. All exhibitors must ensure that all handlers/riders are properly attired in the show ring.
28. Vets will be checking cattle out of transporters and stewards will have the authority to inform exhibitors if they feel animals are unruly and not suited for showing.
